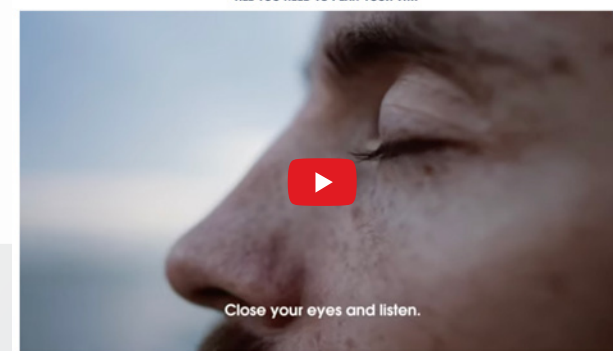

Coming to Lisbon you will have much to see: colourful doors and windows, amazing street art and beautiful tiles. But there is more to enjoy right beneath your feet! The typical Portuguese pavements with patterns in white and black stones called 'calçada portuguesa'.

The literal translation of 'Calçada Portuguesa' is Portuguese Pavement. So, strictly speaking, the general Portuguese sidewalks in white stones are 'Calçada Portuguesa'. But when the Portuguese people talk of 'Calçada Portuguesa' they will refer to the beautiful and artistically patterned pavements, mostly in black and white square shaped cobbles.

In Portugal, paving as a craft appeared around 1500, but it was not until the 19th century that it was executed the way we know it today. Portuguese cities in mainland and overseas were carpeted with this art. Brazil (Copacabana), Macau, Japan or Hawaii are some of the places where you can find samples of this beautiful art.

Patterns were improved and, over the years, they ended up becoming a brand image, in the country and particularly in Lisbon! The Portuguese sidewalk was the motto for developing the event's visual identity.

Combined with the logo's color palette, the different patterns of the Portuguese sidewalk will form the graphic elements of the event's brand image.

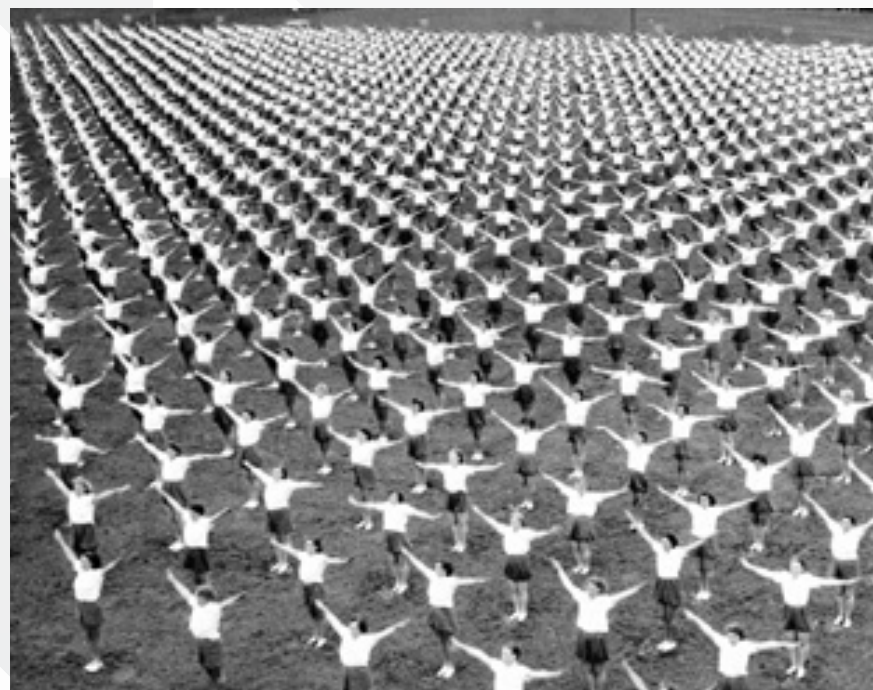


World Gymnaestrada

The World Gymnaestrada is an international gymnastics event that takes place every four years, bringing together gymnasts from all around the globe. Established in 1953 by the International Gymnastics Federation, this unique event promotes gymnastics as a means of physical fitness, artistic expression, friendship and social interaction.

World Gymnaestrada is characterized by its non-competitive nature, allowing participants to showcase their skills in performances that emphasize creativity, teamwork, and the joy of movement. The event typically features a wide range of gymnastic disciplines, including all gymnastics disciplines, along with various dance performances, with and without apparatus.

One of the hallmark features of the World Gymnaestrada is its festive atmosphere, with participants often performing in large groups in front of enthusiastic audiences.

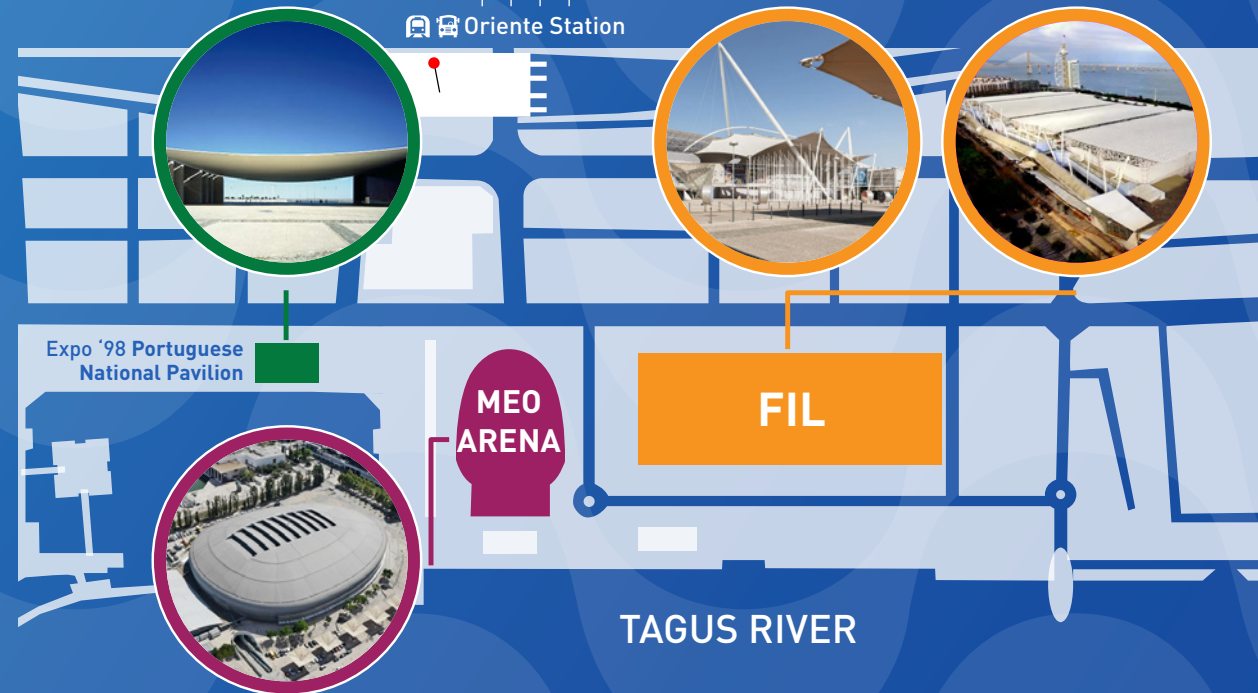

Restelo Stadium

The Restelo stadium, located in the Belém área, is one of the most well known football stadiums in Portugal. Inaugurated in 1956, the stadium has a capacity of around 30.000 audience members. It is known for its distinct architecture and by its picturesque location by the river Tagus.

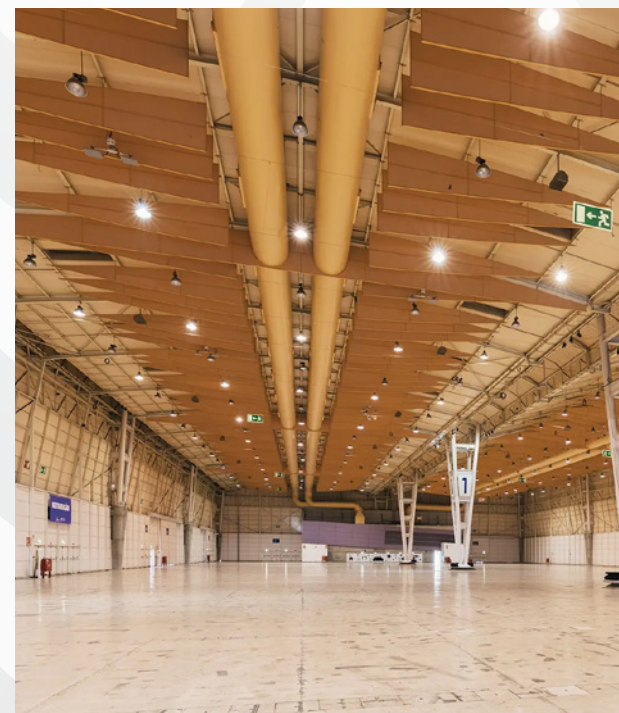
FIL

FIL is the main exhibition centre in Portugal, comprising a total area of 100.000 m², which includes 4 pavilions with enclosed meeting rooms and 1 multi-purpose pavilion with a modern architecture and fully equipped spaces for any type of event. Prepared for both fairs and congresses, FIL occupies a distinguished place among other European Venues.

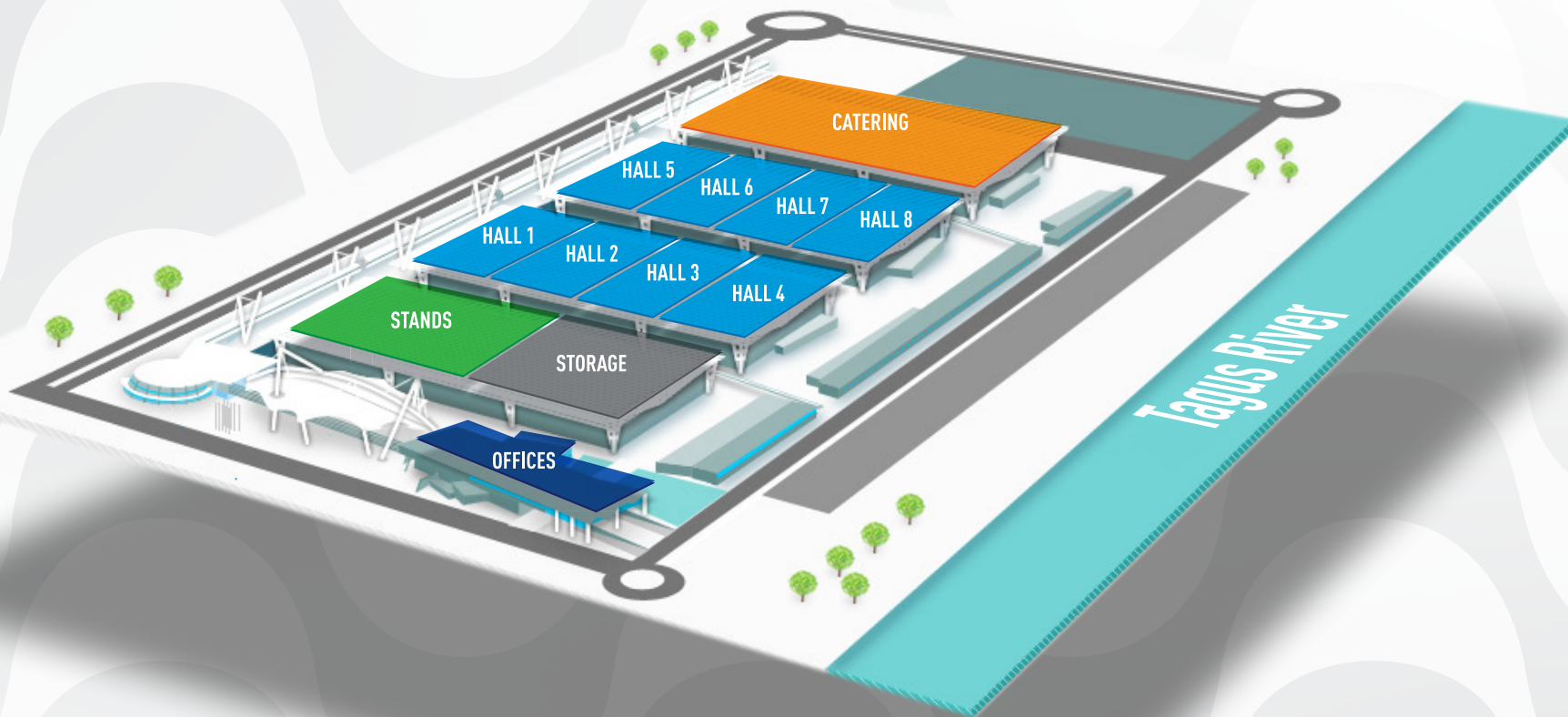
FIL also includes the FIL Meeting Centre, with 3 auditoria, 5 meeting rooms and 2 foyers, offering excellent conditions for any event.

Located in Parque das Nações, near the riverside. Just 10 minutes from Lisbon airport, 200 meters from Gare do Oriente a Multi-modal transit hub, where we can find all public transportation for the city center, FIL and FIL Meeting Centre are synonymous of quality and innovation.

FIL venue will be the heart of the event for the Group Performances, catering and exhibition stands.

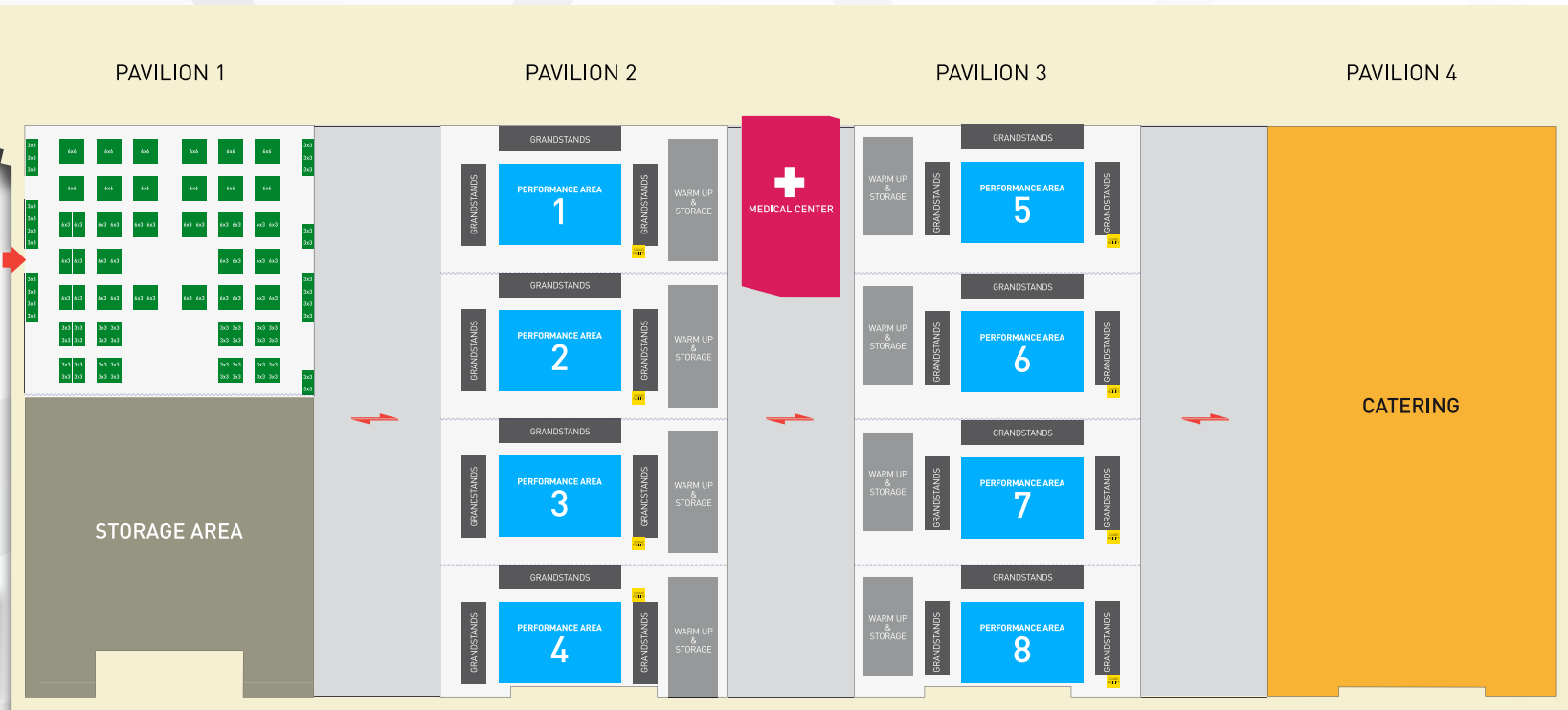

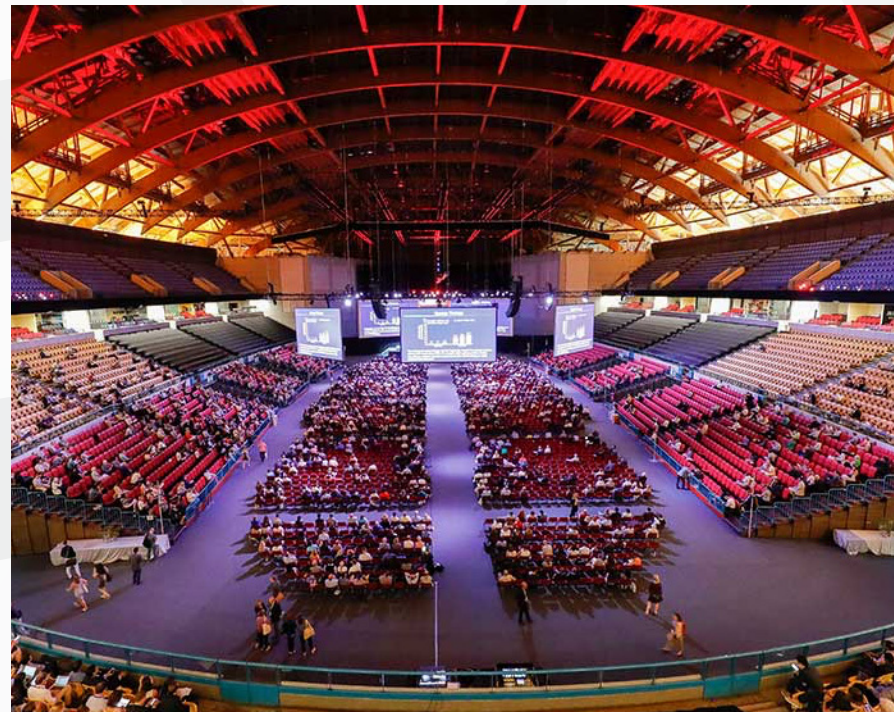
ME0 Arena

In the heart of the Parque das Nações (Lisbon) and 10 minutes from the international airport of Lisbon, we find this multipurpose space with a series of rooms prepared to accommodate the most diverse and important events.

Made up of three integrated areas, all the spaces are easily adapted to the needs and characteristics of each specific event. The Meo Arena room, with an arena of 5 200 m² and a seating capacity for 12.500 hosts all types of events with a unique versatility and an absolute success.

This will be the ideal scenario to host the organisation of the National performances and the World Gymnastics Gala.



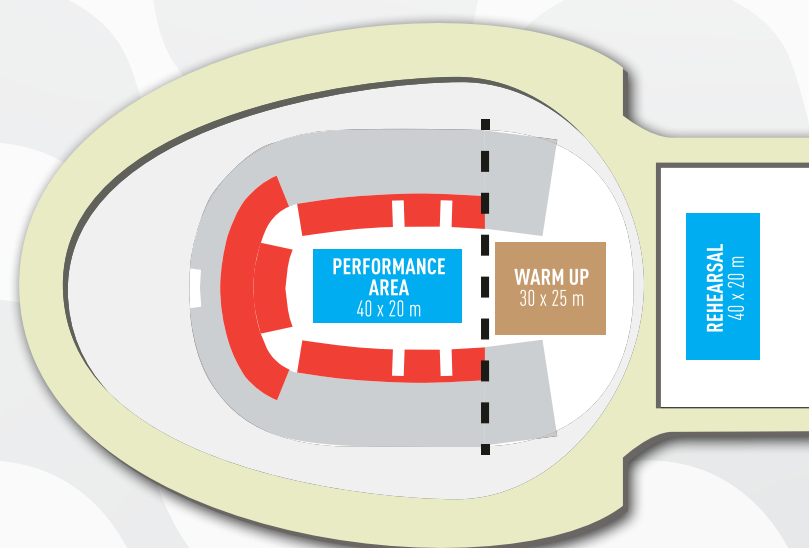
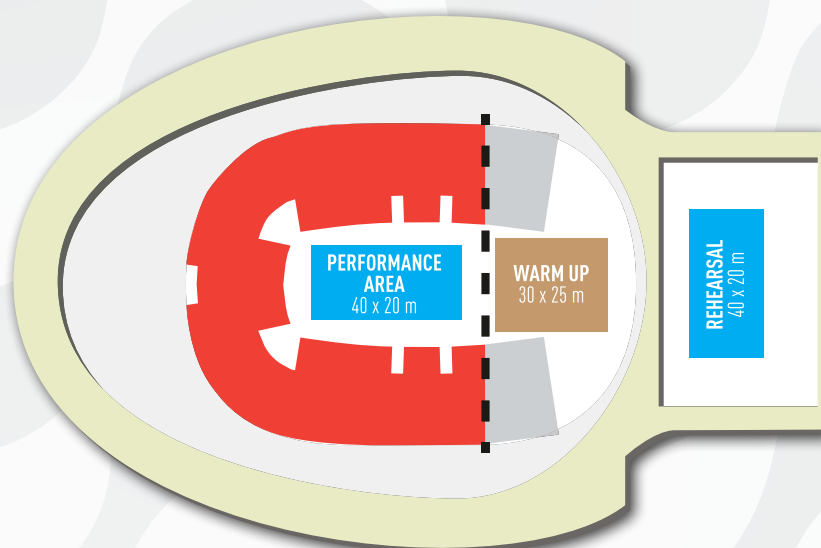

University Stadium of Lisbon

The University Stadium of Lisbon (USL) is an iconic space in the Portuguese capital made for sports and the promotion of leisure activities. Inaugurated in 1947, the stadium is located in a green area in the heart of Lisbon and is an integral part of the University of Lisbon.

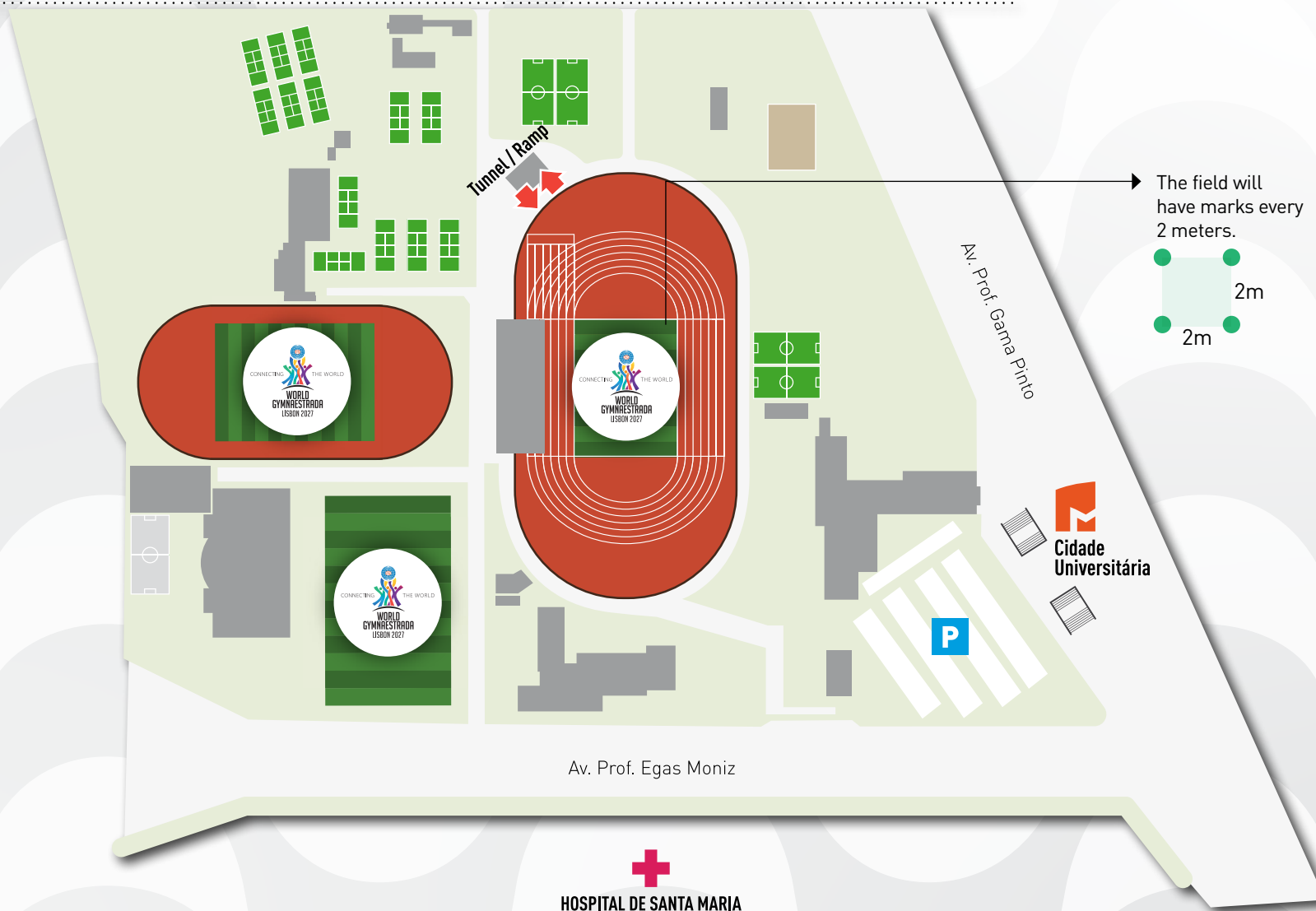
The USL is known for hosting a series of sports events, from university

competitions to national and international events. The stadium has a football field and athletics track as well as several other infrastructures and fields that can support different sports such as football, rugby, golf, padel, volleyball, basketball, swimming and many other sports.

This will be the space reserved for the “Large Group Performances”.

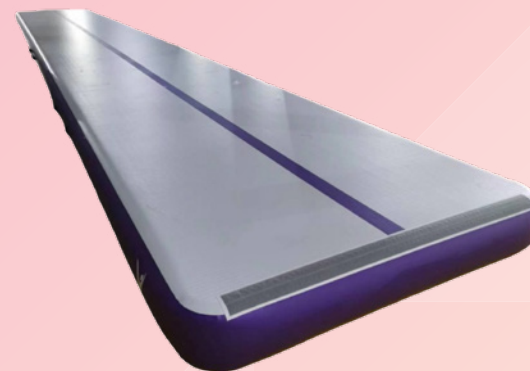

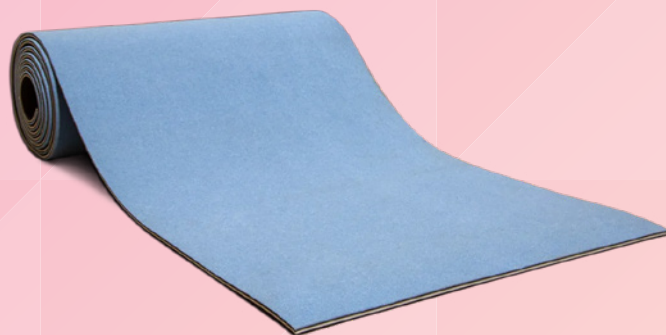

Soon you will be asked to specify the equipment needed for each group/presentation. The LOC will then analyze this data and inform you which equipment you will have at your disposal.



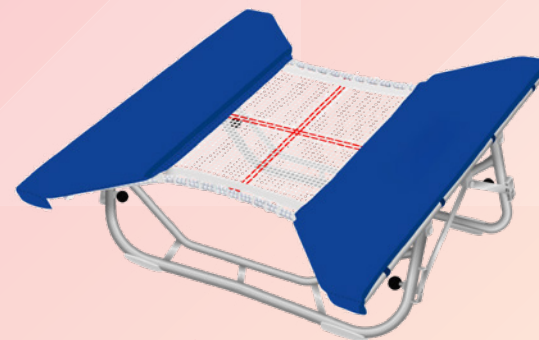

THREADS OF MOTION

Concept and theme

ConnectUs – Threads of Motion is a journey into the energy that emerges when bodies, emotions, and universes collide. Guided by the figure of the Connector, the audience travels from the first spark of existence to the creation of a collective world — a world woven from human, emotional, spiritual, creative, and digital connections.

The show opens with The Spark, the birth of movement, where energy awakens and light takes its first breath. It transitions into The Organic Connection, a warm, grounded universe where physicality and human contact reveal the strength of community.

In The Creative Connection, the world becomes a living canvas: imagination, colour, and expression unfold as movement. This universe flows into The Emotional Connection, where gesture becomes the language of the heart and

empathy shapes the relationships on stage. The journey deepens with The Spiritual Connection, an ethereal realm where the body transcends weight and connection becomes inner awareness. This serenity prepares the stage for The Digital Connection, a precise, geometric universe where movement becomes code and technology pulses like a living organism.

At the system's breaking point comes The Surge, the energetic overload that fractures the network and resets the cycle. This explosive, high-intensity moment, performed by a single group, symbolizes rupture, chaos, and rebirth. The show culminates with The Weave, the final reconnection. All performers return, carrying the colours and rhythms of their universes. The Connector gathers the broken threads, and together they weave a new world — one where every motion is a connection, and every connection holds the power to begin again.

ConnectUs is ultimately a celebration of human energy: of encounter, cooperation, creativity, and the profound impact we create when we move as one.

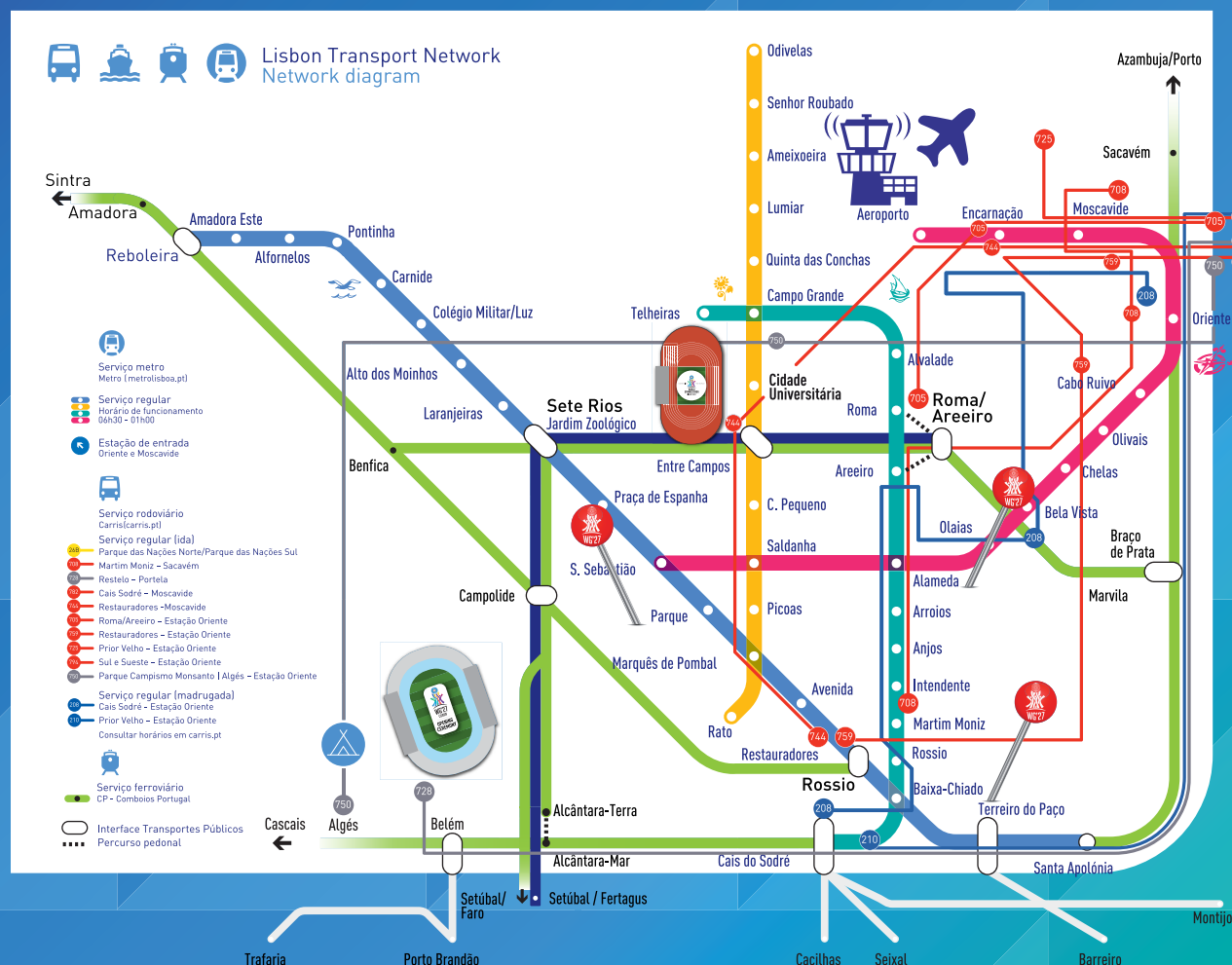
Lisbon is a fantastic city to discover where the modern mixes with the traditional, in many ways. Bringing Gymnastics to the people, by organising City Performances is a must in every World Gymnaestrada! We are going to place outdoor stages in beautiful squares and gardens around the city, where performances will take place from Monday to Friday.

Groups can apply to participate at the World Gymnaestrada only with City Performances. If that is the case, the group presentation of maximum 7 minutes, will be scheduled three times during the week.



If a group already participates in the Group or Large Group or National Performances, it can register additionally for one (1) City Performance of maximum 7 minutes.

Transportation



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

The LOC is responsible for all the local transport service arrangements **within the whole World Gymnaestrada area** (urban center of Lisbon City). All participants will receive a public transport card; a multi day ticket which will be valid during the event dates, from Saturday 10th to Sunday 18th July. The card covers the entire World Gymnaestrada venues.

The World Gymnaestrada 2027 experience goes far beyond the stages and performance moments; the rest areas are also places where people come together. In keeping with Lisbon's tradition, many schools will open their doors, transforming into spaces for gathering, sharing,

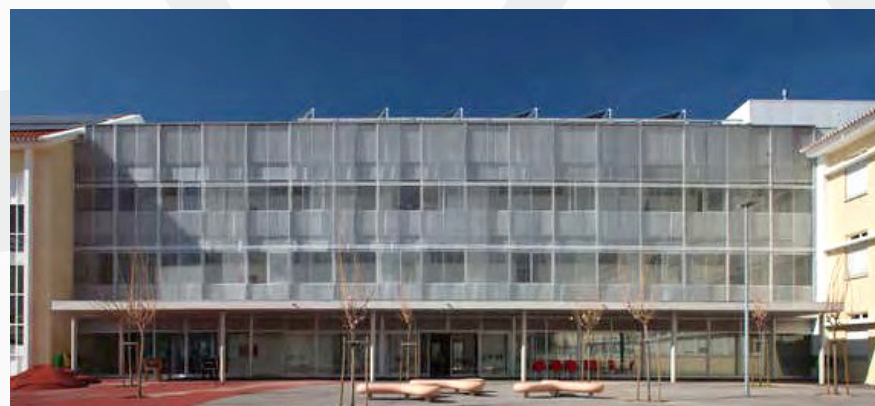

VISA

The majority of foreign nationals wishing to stay in the Portugal for up to three months require a short stay visa or Schengen visa (Schengen visum).

Foreign nationals from the EU, EEA (European Economic Area) or Switzerland are exempt from the visa requirement.

If you are not a national of one of the countries listed above, then you may need a short-stay Schengen visa. This allows you to stay in the Schengen area for a maximum of 90 days within a 180-day period.

Please be sure to start the visa application in time as the waiting times at the visa application centres are longer due to travel increase. You can start your visa application up to 6 months in advance.

You can use the Ministry of Foreign Affairs website (link: <https://vistos.mne.gov.pt/en/short-stay-visas-schengen/general-information/who-needs-a-visa>) to see whether you need a visa or not.
